Say To this Mountain, Move

The disciples seem to me to be in anxiety and fear that they had lost the grace with which they had been entrusted. For they had received power over unclean demons.

So they approached Him in private and asked Him the question, not out of shame (for if the matter had got out and they were criticized, it would have been superfluous for the future to have been ashamed of admitting it in their words) but because what they were going to ask Him was secret and of great moment.

What, then, does Christ say? "Because of your little faith. For truly, I say to you, if you have faith as a grain of mustard seed, you will say to this mountain, 'Move from here

to there,' and it will move; and nothing will be impossible to you." But if you say "Where did they move a mountain?" I will say that they did things much greater than that in raising up innumerable dead. For moving a mountain and moving death from a body are not at all comparable.

After them, other saints, far inferior to the disciples, are said to have moved mountains when necessity demanded. It is clear that the disciples also would have done so had necessity demanded. But if there was never need at that time, do not find fault with them.

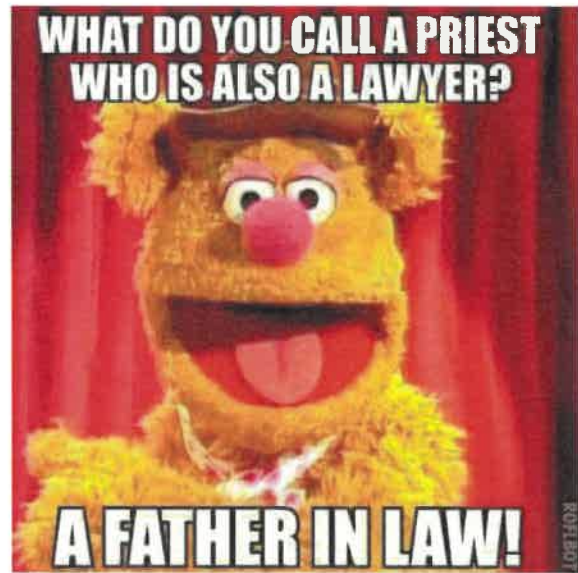

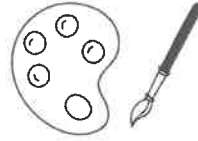

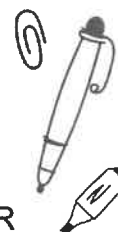

Continuing to honor the Dormition of the Theotokos

This Sunday, we continue to celebrate the feast of the Dormition of the Most Holy Mother of God. As we continue to celebrate today, let us think about the Mother of God and her life. She served the Lord, unbegrudgingly and unreservedly, and she did not truly understand. Her response to Archangel Gabriel and to the Lord was "let it be done to me as you please," and she continued her life in faith, blindly in human terms; truthfully and loyally in terms of her divine Son. She set off in uncharted territory and did so for love of her God. How many times are we called to do the same? How many times in our own world are we called upon to defend our faith and easily relinquish it because of peer pressure and attempting to fit in with those around us?



The Mother of God gave up her entire life from a young girl to her death for our Lord while being human like us--she rejoiced in our Savior's birth; she lamented at His death on the Cross. Her example shows us that faith should be a living, breathing faith, a faith of love, a faith of testament, a faith of endurance unto death. We pray that we can live by the Theotokos' example and allow our love of our faith to shine forth and to help guide those that are lost on the path of life, those that are despondent, those that are hateful and vengeful, those that proclaim to be faithful, yet seek to undermine the teachings of our faith.

As we commemorate our 103rd year as a faith community, let us pray to the Theotokos so that we continue to live a life of faith, not nominally, but through everything that we do and all of the lives that we touch. Let us remember our forefathers and foremothers and the sacrifices they endured to leave us our legacy of faith. Let us support one another and be brave and strong enough to share our faith with those around us, inviting them to our Lord's house to share in His mercy and splendor. May we continue to be a beacon on the hill of an empty town, a source of refuge for those seeking to know God. And may our Lord grant our parish many happy, blessed years, and may our Most Holy Mother keep us under the protective shelter of her mantle.
